Newspaper & Inserts



Notebook & Computer Paper



Cardboard Boxes (empty & flatten)



Cereal & Snack Boxes (empty & flatten)



Glass Bottles, Jugs & Jars



Phone Books (recycle covers with cardboard)



Junk Mail (shred personal information)



Magazines



Plastic Jugs & Bottles (No.1 through No.7 – No Styrofoam)



Metal Cans (aluminum, steel & aerosol)

## RECYCLING CENTERS ONLY

Motor Oil Filters



Motor Oil Bottles



Large Appliances



Tires



Batteries (all types)



Electronics (erase all data)



Yard Trimmings



Scrap Metal



Cooking Oil

**NOTE:** The following items **ARE NOT ACCEPTED** curbside or at recycling centers: plastic bags (recycle at local grocery stores); glass cookware, dishes or ceramics; Styrofoam; paper plates, napkins, plasticware or silverware; light bulbs; aluminum foil or trays; mirrors; or wrapping paper.
