## **I. Horry County Solid Waste Authority (SWA)**

Horry County Council created the Horry County Solid Waste Authority in 1990 through passage of Ordinance No. 60-90 and 78-13. The Horry County Solid Waste Authority in accordance with Horry County Ordinance No. 02-09 will administer the Ordinance, which regulates Solid Waste and Construction and Demolition Waste collected or generated in Horry County.

## **II. Solid Waste Collection and Disposal License**

All persons, companies, partnerships or other entities engaged in hauling for commercial collection, pick-up, transfer, removal and/or disposal of solid waste and construction and demolition waste in Horry County shall obtain a license issued by the Horry County Solid Waste Authority. These regulations apply to the collection and disposal of all solid waste and construction and demolition waste generated in Horry County. In addition, the provisions of Horry County Ordinance No. 02-09 shall be applicable to all licenses issued herein and shall be fully complied with by licensee.

Failure to obtain such license shall prohibit any such person, company, partnership or other entity from conducting hauling for commercial collection, pick-up, transfer, removal and/or disposal of solid waste and construction and demolition waste activities within Horry County. Failure to comply with the conditions and requirements of a license issued hereunder, failure to comply with the requirements of the SWA's Facility Rules and Regulations, those Rules and Regulations are included herein and with annual updates that will be provided, and/or failure to comply with the local laws, shall subject any such license holder to the penalties set forth in Article XI: Enforcement: Penalties of Ordinance No. 02-09 for Horry County, including but not limited to monetary penalties and/or revocation of hauler's license.

The SWA reserves the right to deny a license to any person or entity that does not meet the Rules and Regulations of Ordinance No. 02-09 which engage in hauling of commercial collection, pick-up, transfer, removal and/or disposal of solid waste and construction and demolition waste in Horry County. Any license issued shall be in the nature of a privilege subject to the terms, conditions, rules and regulations in Ordinance No. 02-09 as set forth herein and shall not be deemed to create a property interest with respect to said license in the license holder. The SWA, on behalf of Horry County Council, reserves the right to revoke any license for failure to comply with the license terms, conditions, rules and regulations and will not renew a license in the event the license holder has failed or is failing to comply with SWA rules, regulations and applicable statutes or such renewal conflicts with any other applicable provision of law regulating the collection, transport, and/or disposal of solid waste and construction and demolition waste within Horry County.

## **III. Procedure**

Any person seeking a license for the business of hauling, collecting, transporting or disposing of solid waste and construction and demolition waste shall file an application for a license on a form provided by the SWA. The form shall be filled out completely and submitted along with any additional required documentation, or it will be returned or denied, at the SWA's discretion. Applicant shall supply all information required to the SWA on such forms acceptable to the SWA at the time the license application is submitted.

Upon receipt of the license application, the SWA staff shall review the application for completeness and accuracy. If information presented by the applicant is accurate and complete, and applicant meets the requirements of the Ordinance, the license will be approved.

If a license is denied, the applicant can request a hearing by the Horry County Solid Waste Authority's Appeals Committee. The Appeals Committee's decision in this matter shall be final.

#### **IV. Terms and Conditions of License**

1. This license shall be valid for a term of three (3) year and renewed in accordance with the provisions set forth herein. Application must be submitted at least 30 days prior to effective date of license.
2. The license holder shall comply with all Federal, State, County and SWA requirements, statutes, laws, rules and regulations, including the SWA's payment policy.
3. The license holder shall respond to any notice it receives from the SWA which requests a response in the fashion and within the time required set forth in any such notice. The license holder must provide weight tickets showing tonnage, time emptied, container number, truck number, and weight ticket number of all waste regulated under Horry County Ordinance 02-09, if emptied at any location not approved as a Designated Facility by the (5) fifth business day of each month.
4. The license holder shall identify all trucks used for hauling, collecting, transporting or disposing of solid waste and construction and demolition waste with numbers that are unique to each truck. The numbers shall be located on the driver side front of each vehicle and shall be at least 3" in height.
5. The license holder shall place the license decal issued by the SWA on all large trucks used for hauling, collecting, transporting or disposing of solid waste and construction and demolition waste. The license decal shall be located on the upper left hand side of driver's door of each vehicle and must be the numbered decal issued to that truck. Pickup Trucks, Stake Type and Small Van Type the license decal shall be located on the Lower left hand side on inside of Windshield of each vehicle and must be the numbered decal issued to that truck.
6. The license holder shall identify all construction and demolition waste containers with two alphabetic letters and numbers that are unique to each waste container (Example SW1234). The alphabetic letters and numbers shall be located on the driver side front of each waste container, plus the on the rear door of each waste container and shall be at least 6" in height. The SWA shall issue those numbers to be use by each applicant for customer owned containers. All license holders shall have construction and demolition waste containers meeting these requirements before emptying at a Designated Facility.
7. The license holder shall provide to the SWA's Scalehouse Attendant the address and/or location of where solid waste or construction and demolition waste was generated. The information may include but not limited to physical address, lot number, subdivision, city or other information as deemed necessary to validate origination and disposal of waste.
8. The license holder shall provide to Horry County Code Enforcement the address and/or location of where solid waste or construction and demolition waste was generated from upon request. The information may include but not limited to trip ticket, pull ticket, weight ticket or other information as deemed necessary to validate origination and disposal of waste.
9. The license holder agrees that the SWA and/or Horry County Code Enforcement shall have the right, but is in no way obligated to inspect all collection vehicles owned or operated by a license holder and used for the hauling of solid waste and construction and demolition waste in Horry County at any time without

prior notice to determine whether the license holder is in compliance with all solid waste transport and disposal rules and regulations and license conditions.

10. The license holder shall also comply with Horry County Solid Waste Handling and Disposal Ordinance No. 50-01. All loads of solid waste or construction and demolition waste shall be covered and/or tarped at the time of delivery to the SWA's Designated Facilities. All loads shall remain tarped on SWA's Designated Facilities until driver reaches the location to unload.
11. All waste collected and/or generated in Horry County shall be delivered to a Designated Facility. The facilities currently designated for solid waste or construction and demolition waste are at the following address:

Each instance in which solid waste or construction and demolition waste collected and/or generated in Horry County is delivered to a non-designated facility shall constitute a violation of the SWA terms and conditions of Haulers License and/or Horry County Ordinance No. 02-09.

## **V. Enforcement**

Failure to comply with any provision of Horry County Ordinance No. 02-09, these rules and regulations or any license issued pursuant hereto shall subject the license holder to action by the SWA and/or Horry County Code Enforcement in accordance with the Horry County Ordinance No. 02-09 Article XI: Enforcement Penalties. Such action shall result in the issuance of a decision that imposes penalties and/or license revocation, in accordance with these provisions.

## **VI. Severability**

If any section, part of a section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of these rules and regulations is for any reason held or declared to be unconstitutional, inoperative or void, such holding of invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of these rules and regulations.

## **VII. Disclaimer**

By granting a license the SWA does not assume any liability of the license holder and specifically disclaims any liability of the license holder's operations. License holder agrees to indemnify and hold harmless from all claims, costs, judgments, penalties or fines ("claims"), directly or indirectly arising out of license holder's operations. This indemnity and hold harmless extends to, but not limited to, any and all claims arising from license holder's handling, release or discharge of any Hazardous Materials, as defined by law, or violation of any environmental law.
