**General requirements**

Under general supervision, he is responsible for the operations of division-related equipment to move loads, transport materials, and maintain the site. It also performs routine and preventive maintenance and repair on all related equipment, including but not limited to checking fluid levels, tire pressure, etc. Reports to the Director of Operations and Planning

**General Responsibilities**

- Operates all types of heavy machinery.
- Responsible for and performs preventive maintenance of the operated equipment. Check all fluid levels to make sure your equipment is operational.
- Assists with all other responsibilities within the department.
- Interacts and communicates with various related groups and individuals, including clients, supervisors, co-workers, other Authority personnel, etc.
- Performs routine maintenance of the landfill and all other properties owned or operated by the Horry County Solid Waste Authority.
- Assist in maintaining records of all Authority-owned properties, including deeds and plans.
- Build roads, trails, and the necessary fire lines on SWA property.
- It maintains landfill ownership as well as storm remnant sites to ensure compliance.
- Assists in the forest management of approximately 1200 acres of pine forest and mixed hardwoods and a 1-3 year burn rotation for wildlife and environmental management practices.
- Inspect all hectares of forest for potential wildlife offenders, plant and forest product diseases, road and/or trail improvement.
- Assist in the planning, development, and implementation of land management policies.
- Performs other related tasks or assignments as needed.

**Minimum Educational Requirements**

- High school graduate or equivalent with a minimum of two (2) years of experience in operation, minor maintenance of related heavy machinery and property management, or any combination of training and experience that provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities
- Valid South Carolina driver's license. Class B CDL preferred
